



Hi I came across your website as I was looking for a headstone for our little angel Leanne Marie Mohler. At 2:30 this morning, my husband wakes me up and tells me he wants to take me somewhere. We live about 3 blocks from where our daughter is buried. We pulled up and immediately I began to cry. As I looked at the spot where she is buried, empty with no headstone. I was saddened. Here she has lain for almost 10 months and we still haven't been able to

get that headstone. All the other babies next to her had beautiful headstones in memory of them. Here's our story, I had a wonderful pregnancy. I had no complications. At about 30 weeks, I started having contractions but nothing really to bad. At 33 weeks, I had the worst contractions, I started going into pre-labor on December 14, 2007. Around 1:00 am I woke my husband up and we left for the hospital. We arrived there within minutes which seemed like forever. I was immediately admitted and dilated at a 10. They hooked up the heart monitor and they said that there was no heart beat....as I laid there in a lot of pain, I told myself that she was fine. They were just saying that, how could that be. We had just had our 3D-4D ultrasound that week. Leanne is fine. She was just kicking the previous day. As my husband stood by my side, holding it together I delivered our little angel Leanne Marie. It didn't even hit me until I got to hold her for the first time, that I wasn't going to be taking her home. I cried and cried. She was only 3 lbs, so tiny with lots of dark hair. Erich held me so tight and he cried too. As I laid there in pain holding our only child, I remember feeling her spirit. Because of our religious beliefs, we understand and know where she is. We are married in the St.

Louis temple and we are a family for eternity. We can and will be with her again someday. With all the support that we had from our families, church members and friends. We have grown so much closer together as a couple and to Heavenly Father. We both feel so blessed to have gone through this experience with each other. With the complications of Losing of daughter Leanne, we had received so many answers to our many prayers. We are currently expecting another baby due in February. With my high risk pregnancy, I feel content and I'm just as excited for this baby as I was with our first baby. We miss our Leanne dearly and think about her often. At times, I wonder what she's doing up there. With all the doctors' bills, school loans that we are currently paying, we just haven't been able to afford the headstone. We would be so grateful to have a headstone for our little angel.
