

Hi my name is Carole Holmes-Seamans, me and my husband Jason had a beautiful baby boy Dec 29, 2008 sadly the day we had him I had my tubes tied so we can not have any more children... He was my husband's only child and my 4th. It was rough from the start; he was flown out to a Nic Unit in Tulsa Oklahoma because he was breathing too fast... After many tests they decided he had inhaled amniotic fluid and discharged up with a happy healthy baby :) We drove the 4 hours home things were wonderful other than the fact I was let go from my job the week I had planned on going back to work... economy sucks, my husband has some problems that prevent him from being employed and we have applied for his SSI... the week after losing my job... on Feb 18, 2009 I woke up thinking OMG Nick slept through the night.. and any mother knows that the first time they sleep is a wonderful/scary thing all at the same time... I went to the restroom before I went to wake Nick to eat.... I walk in the room and instantly stopped and screamed... the one fear that any mother has came true for me I found my son in his crib discolored, stiff and gone..... As everyone knows the time at the funeral you are numb and aren't thinking don't really care about anything... The home provided funerals and a casket for babies but we were stuck with the grave space and after that we had nothing. Since my son has died we have had over \$30,000 in bills that were not covered, including the life flight out and his time in ICU and it kills me to know that my baby Nicholas Cain Seamans is laying in the cemetery in an unmarked grave because I can't afford to provide one for him. He is buried in Greenwood, Arkansas. We would greatly appreciate ANY help we could to get a stone for our baby..... he died from SIDS....

I thank you for any help you can do... it's heartbreaking to know that he is still there with only the little marker the funeral home provides and knowing there is nothing I can do to change it. I thank God that he led me to your website.
